HOUSE AUTHORIZATION: House Subcommittee on Space

Noted in draft report the likely progression of NASA requests are not consistent with a 5-yr freeze on domestic discretionary spending:

- **1993: \$15B +;**
- **1994: + \$1B;**
- **1995: + \$3B.**

House bill restructures NASA spending into three Titles:

I. "Core" space programs:

- **Space Station Freedom, core science programs (all science except EOS), commercial programs, aeronautic research, space technology development, manned space flight and transportation, and institutional funding.**
- **These activities would be authorized for three years, with only inflationary growth.**


