

**MELV - MEDIUM EXPENDABLE LAUNCH VEHICLE** 



- CERES IS FUNDED FOR A MID-INCLINATION FLIGHT PLANNED FOR 2000




## Rebaselined EOS Mission Profile

### EOS Science Budgets

- All science funding programmed under one UPN
  - Investigators responsible for allocating funding as they deem appropriate for algorithm development, SCFs, and scientific research (without restriction)
  - Investigators must continue to report actuals for funding disbursed in their regular (533Q) financial reports



### Algorithm Science Reviews

- Deadline for submission of revised ATBDs is November 1 (MODIS, CERES, MISR)
- ATBDs to be submitted to the PSO electronically for HTML mark-up and inclusion in the PSO World Wide Web home page
- ATBDs also to be available for anonymous FTP from the authors' home machines
