# New NASA Software Standards



- All NASA Center ClOs will soon be directed to ensure that all NASA employees have access to an interoperable workstation equipped with standard software for the following functions:
  - Word Processing
  - Spreadsheet
  - Presentations
  - Electronic Mail
  - Calendar/Scheduling
  - Basic Internet Client Suite (e.g., FTP, browser)
- Facilitates platform-independent interactions

- Chameleon v4.5 (commercial TCP/IP & telnet s/w)
- QuickTime v2.0.3 (shareware for playing movies)
- VMPEG v1.6a Lite (freeware for playing movies)
- WDUA v2.1b (freeware for conducting x.500 searches)

#### Optional:

WinZip v6.0/with PK Ware (compression/decompression shareware)



# Internet Software for Mac Platform



#### Mandatory:

- Netscape v1.12 (commercial WWW viewer)
- Adobe Acrobat Reader v2.1 (freeware for viewing/ printing)

#### Recommended:

- MacTCP v2.0.6 (commercial TCP/IP software)
- Fetch v2.1.2 (shareware for FTP)
- Sparkle v2.4.5 (freeware for playing movies)
- maX.500 v2.0.2 (freeware for x.500 searches)

#### Optional:

Stuffit Expander v3.5.2 (compression/decompression freeware)

# Adobe Acrobat Products & Their Capabilities



- Acrobat Reader (freeware)
  - can view/print Portable Document Format (PDF) files
  - Weblink Plug-in is Netscape compatible
- Acrobat Exchange (commercial software)
  - generates PDF files
  - can view/print PDF files
  - contains features for adding value to PDF files
- Acrobat Distiller (commercial)
  - "distills" PDF files from PostScript
- Acrobat Capture (commercial)
  - converts hardcopy to PDF

### **Short-term Solutions**

- Recommend using common doc development tools:
  - MS Word or WordPerfect --> Mac, PC, or UNIX
  - MS PowerPoint
- And/Or, save docs in one of following formats:
  - RTF
  - PDF
  - PostScript
- Save graphics as:
  - EPS for inclusion in documents
  - GIF or JPEG for placement on WWW







- Recent & Planned Upgrades to EFS
  - Use "Launch Association ..." to view in 3rd-party application, including:
    - » MS Word & WordPerfect
    - » PostScript
    - » Excel
    - » MS PowerPoint
    - » PDF filter forthcoming
  - May use Client Print.API to print hardcopy locally
    - » UNIX Client forthcoming
- MODARCH FTP site established







- Adobe Acrobat Procured
  - Acrobat converts any document to PDF
  - Exchange allows viewing, navigating through, and printing
  - Exchange allows insertion of annotations, building hyperlinks, and addition of security controls
  - Exchange allows Copy & Paste of text & graphics from PDF to MS Word and/or WordPerfect
  - Exchange Weblink allows WWW links; free software from http://www.adobe.com/Acrobat/Weblink.html
- MAST procures/distributes Acrobat Exchange to entire Science Team as needed
  - available for Mac, PC, & UNIX (Sun OS & Solaris) users







- MODIS WWW test review pages already in place
  - Marked up docs placed immediately on "stealth Web" for review; or
  - placed on ftp site, Web-accessible, in either PDF or PostScript format--compatible viewers include:
    - » Acrobat Distiller
    - » Acrobat Exchange
    - » GhostScript View (Mac/UNIX)
    - » Drop•PS (Mac)
    - » others?







- The aforementioned solutions provide options (that will be mixed & matched) for:
  - Joint authoring of documents
  - electronic distribution for review & edit
  - electronic distribution for printing



### **Possible Long-term Solutions**



- PixTex/EFS v4.0 release, in 12 22 months, will include:
  - New TRS search engine
  - Optional addition of new XRS search engine
  - New "roll-your-own", modularized fileroom viewer
    - » WWW-compatible
    - » Acrobat compatible
- Acrobat Catalog (??)
  - MAST creates alternate full-text archive index system for searching among PDF files
  - Perhaps best to wait for future version







- Acrobat Capture
  - All incoming hardcopy will be converted to PDF
  - All previously scanned copy w/ be re-OCRed and converted to PDF
- MODARCH docs increasingly hyperlinked according to relational information threads
  - This input comes from Team member submissions, original authors only



### **MODARCH Security Issues**



- Questions as to types of data on MODIS that should be rendered internationally available
  - MODIS Team Member reports and correspondence OK
  - MODIS Specifications OK
  - SBRC CDRL documents about 80% of archive restricted
- MODARCH divides into two partitions
  - public access (ATBDs, minutes, reports, specs, etc.)
  - password protected (technical data on MODIS instrument)
    - » acceptable level of security and procedures for distributing password become issues



### Who Has Access to Restricted Partition?



- MODIS Team Members who are:
  - U.S. Citizens
  - U.S. Greencard Holders
- Anyone else must submit a request in writing to be approved by EOS Project Manager
- MAST plans to seek reversal of decision to render entire archive public domain once again
